

EMERGENCY APPEAL!

His Holiness, Amica-san and volunteers from Cealo Global Harmony Japan are in Sri Lanka continuing their work in Andarabedda, Trincomalee, Seruwawila, and Galgamua. These villages are in remote areas of Sri Lanka and unfortunately, reliable transportation is not available. On previous trips, His Holiness and Amica-san would travel 8 to 10 hours on rugged roads in a van owned by Venerable Subuthi, a Buddhist monk who supervises the Direct Action programs in Cealo's absence. The aging van was in constant use, transporting rice and other supplies to the villages. Over the past year, the van has broken down a number of times and created immense challenges for Ven. Subuthi to deliver supplies to these impoverished villages. A couple of months ago, the van broke down and was deemed unrepairable. Since that time, villagers have been trekking the heavy supplies in by foot and other means. His Holiness says "it is time to get Ven. Subuthi a new bus!"

Volunteers at the Foundation for Global Harmony decided to start a fundraising campaign for Subuthi's Bus.
